**NOTES:**

1. This map is part of the Matamata-Piako District Council's Land Transport Bylaw 2008.
2. Scales shown on this map are approximate.
3. Dimensions show the boundaries of a speed limit for the purpose of the Bylaw.
4. Speed limits boundaries that cross the road do so at right angles from one side of the road to the other, by the shortest distance.
5. A speed limit boundary marked along a road is deemed to run along the edge of the carriageway.
6. All Matamata-Piako Council roads shown on this map have a speed limit of 100km/hr, unless marked with a different speed limit.
7. This map is held on Matamata-Piako District Council Speed Limit Register file number RSB 522219.
8. Speed Limits on State Highways shown on this map are not part of the Matamata-Piako District Council Land Transport Bylaw 2008: refer to New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) for details of these limits.
9. The 60km/h variable zone is permanently on between 8:25-9:00am and 2:55-3:15pm school days only.
10. The 60km/h variable zone is vehicle activated by vehicles approaching Tautiti/Ngutumanga Road along Bowler or Mellon Road outside of the times in Note 9


