The submission must be dated, signed by you and include the following information:

- a) Your name, postal address, telephone number and fax number (if applicable);
- b) Reference to the submission of which the further submission is being made;
- c) Reasons for your support or opposition to the submission;
- d) Whether or not you wish to be heard in support of your further submission;
- e) The decision you wish Council to make.

You must also send a copy of your submission to the original submitter within five working days.

Further submission forms are available at Council offices, libraries and the MPDC website.

Under the Resource Management Act 1991, the process for public participation in the consideration of the proposed plan change is as follows:

- If a person making a submission or a further submission asks to be heard in support of his or her submission; a hearing must be held; and
- The Council will give its decision on the proposed plan change (including the reasons for accepting or rejecting the submissions); and

- Any person who has made a submission or further submission has the right to appeal the decision on the proposed plan change in the Environment Court.
