### **DECISION ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application by Nigel John Vickery for a manager's certificate. The applicant manages the sale of alcohol at the Kereone Rugby & Sports Club.

The application is made pursuant to s.219 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. Section 222 of that Act sets out the matters that must be considered in determining an application for a manager's certificate.

The application was referred to the Police and Inspector for comment as required by s.225 of the 2012 Act. Initially the Police had opposed this application due to suitability, this has since been withdrawn.


It is noted that Mr Vickery failed to renew his licence on two occasions, it is important renewals are submitted on time as this can impact on the suitability of the applicant.

Mr Vickery holds the qualifications prescribed by s.218 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
