

Application to Register Dog(s)

For 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012
Section 36, Dog Control Act 1996



All dog owners with dogs ordinarily kept in the Matamata-Piako district must register with the Matamata-Piako District Council.

It is an offence to keep a dog older than three months that is unregistered. On conviction, a Court may impose a fine up to \$3,000.

It is an offence, in making an application for the registration of a dog, to make any written statement knowing the statement to be false. On conviction, a Court may impose a fine of up to \$3,000.

No occupier of a property within an urban area may keep or permit to be kept on each separate premise more than two dogs older than three months without obtaining a permit.

*Owner's Date of Birth (Section 34 (2) (a), Dog Control Act)

Your date of birth is required to enable you to be distinguished from other persons with the same name. Certainty of identification is required in the enforcement of the provisions of the Dog Control Act 1996.

Release of your information

The information kept on this form will be kept by Matamata-Piako District Council but may only be used for lawful official purposes and will not be generally available to the public. However, Section 35 of the Dog Control Act 1996 allows the name and address of the owner of any specified dog may be made available to any person who has made a written application for this information. The territorial authority must be satisfied of the identity of that applicant and that the information is required for one of a limited number of specified purposes, such as returning a lost dog to its owner or seeking compensation for damage.

Particulars of Dog(s)

The Department of Internal Affairs is managing the National Dog Database (NDD), which will hold the information on dogs required by the Dog Control Act 1996.

The National Dog Database is part of the measures introduced in the Act to improve public safety through the use of stronger deterrents, preventative measures, more extensive powers of enforcement, better information about dogs and dog safety education.

As directed by central government District Councils are only able to use approved breed types and colours.
