Resource Consents Grant

An annual fund of \$25,000 is available for not-for-profit community groups who need financial assistance with the cost of resource consents.

Community groups can apply for funding at any time of the year and can ask for up to \$5000 towards the cost of the resource consent process.

To apply for funding, your group must be a not-for-profit community group and should:

- have a high ratio of volunteers to paid employees
- have a high degree of public access to the group
- primarily be funded from grants, donations, subscriptions or similar and not from fees, charges or funding from central government

The grant has been introduced as part of Council's contribution to the social and cultural well-being of the community. Each application will be considered by Councillors to determine whether or not funding will be awarded.

Qualified and registered trades people and companies are invited to register their interest to provide building maintenance services to Council owned buildings and property. A register will be kept for each of the three towns – Te Aroha, Morrinsville and Matamata for the following trades:
