

## **DECISION ON THE PAPERS**

This is an application for a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under an existing on-licence in respect of a premises situated at 81 Whitaker Street, Te Aroha known as the Grand Tavern. The takeover date is 4 February 2019.

The premises is a tavern. It has a current on-licence with an expiry date of 23 August 2021.

The applicant Anika & Co Limited has one director Venkata Srivalli Sai Manasa GIDIPATI. Venkata has worked in the hospitality industry for a number of years. Venkata is not the holder of a manager's certificate. Two current staff member holding a managers certificate will remain in the employment of the applicant. Their details are attached. The applicant has also supplied the details of another two staff members who also hold manager's certificates.

No matters in opposition to this temporary authority have been raised by the Inspector or by the Police.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard and we grant the applicant a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under the existing licence.



Section 136(4) of the Act requires the Committee, on making an order, to impose any conditions that the Act requires an on or off-licence to be issued subject to, may impose any conditions that the Act enables the licence to be issued subject to and may impose any other reasonable conditions it thinks fit. Sections 112, 116 and 117 of the Act detail compulsory and discretionary conditions of the licence in force.

The temporary authority is subject to the following conditions in addition to the existing conditions of the licence in force:

- a) It is a condition of this Temporary Authority that the holder must comply with all the conditions of the current on-licence, and the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- b) The holder is to immediately display this Temporary Authority next to the substantive on-licence.
- c) That an application for an on-licence be made within two months of the date of issue.

The applicant's attention is drawn to s.136(5) of the Act which states that the person authorised by this order has the same duties, obligations, and liabilities, as the holder of the underlying on-licence concerned.

The certificate can be issued immediately.
