Public Notice of Summary of Submissions on Proposed Plan Change 54 - Papakāinga

Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991

The Matamata-Piako District Council has prepared a summary of submissions on: Plan Change 54 – Papakāinga. This plan change seeks to enable papakāinga to meet the needs, desires and values of tangata whenua, while also managing potential adverse effects on the environment. Provision for papakāinga development is important to promote the economic, cultural and social health and wellbeing of the Māori community, and to achieve the matter of national importance of enabling Māori to establish and maintain their relationship, cultures and traditions with their ancestral lands.

The following persons may make a further submission on the plan change:

- any person representing a relevant aspect of public interest;
- any person who has an interest in the proposed plan change greater than the interest that the general public has; and

The further submission must be made using Form 6 of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Regulations 2003 and must be limited to a matter in support of or in opposition to an original submission to the plan change. Copies of this form are available from the locations listed above (i.e. any Council office or library, or on the Council website). You must also send a copy of your submission to the original submitter within five working days of lodging your submission with Council.

Further submissions close at 4.30pm on Wednesday, 26 April 2023, being no later than 10 working days after the day on which this public notice is given.
