DECISION ON THE PAPERS

This is an application for a temporary authority for the premises known as Workmans Café and Bar. This application deals with an On Licence that expires 11 September 2023.

This application has been made by Due South Pub and Grub Limited. They are a newly formed company being incorporated on the 17th of June 2022. There are two directors, Donnevon and Jeanne Van Wyk.

The applicant is currently trading on a temporary licence, which expires on the 27th of October 2022.

This is the second application for a temporary authority; it was received on the 11th of October 2022.

The applicant has submitted a substantive application; unfortunately, the MOH and Police have not submitted a report. Council and the applicant believe the MOH and Police reports will not be received in time to complete the substantive application.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard and we grant the applicant a second temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol under the existing licence.

Section 136(4) of the Act requires the Committee, on making an order, to impose any conditions that the Act requires an on or off-licence to be issued subject to, may impose any conditions that the Act enables the licence to be issued subject to and may impose

any other reasonable conditions it thinks fit. Sections 112, 116 and 117 of the Act detail compulsory and discretionary conditions of the licence in force.


The temporary authority is subject to the following conditions in addition to the existing conditions of the licence in force:

- a) It is a condition of this Temporary Authority that the holder must comply with all the conditions of the current) On-licence, and the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- b) The temporary authority must be displayed next to the base licence attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrance.

The applicant's attention is drawn to s136(5) of the Act which states that the person authorised by this order has the same duties, obligations, and liabilities, as the holder of the underlying On-licence concerned.

The certificate can be issued immediately.
